

10 x 10 STANDARD TENT

- 2- Soft Case with Wheels
- 3- Canopy
- 4- Stake Kit








Set-Up

Step 1


Place Frame (1) it at your desired location.

In tandem with another person, separate the legs of the Frame (1) until they are extended afull arms length.



Step 3


Attach the Canopy (3) by connecting the loop strips on the Canopy (3) corners with the hook strips on the four legs of the Frame (1).



Step 2


Unfold your Canopy (3) and drape over the Frame (1). Position

the apex of the Canopy (3) with the center pole of the Frame (1).



Step 4

Stand diagonal to each other, lift and separate the legs of the Frame (1). The Frame (1) will open a little at atime so alternate ends until the Frame (1) no longer expands.



DO NOT DRAG FRAME-THIS COULD BEND THE LEGS

Set-Up Continued...

Step 5

With top lever or button in the unlock position, lift the framework upwards until it locks into place on the legs of the Frame (1).






Push in button

Step 7

Lift the apex of the Canopy (3) into place by turning the arank clockwise until the Canopy (3) is taut. Do not over-crank.



Step 6

Place your foot on the base of the tent leg as you release and extend the telescoping legs. Raise the tent to your desired height and lock the legs into place.

NOTE:

To move an assembled frame, make sure aperson is located at each leg. Lift and transport carefully in unison.




Place your foot on the base asyou lift



Secure with Stakes

Secure by looping rope through the "D" ring located on each corner of the canopy.





*FRAME MUST BESECURED DOWN TO PREVENT WIND FROM LIFTING TENT AND CAUSING DAMAGE. NOT SECURING TENT PROPERLY VOIDS THE WARRANTY.

Storage

Remove Canopy (3) from Frame (1) and collapse. Store collapsed Frame (1) in soft case (provided)

Store in a cool dry location. To clean, wipe with damp cloth.

MAKE SURE TO TAKE SPECIAL CARE TO NOT DRAG THE FRAME WHEN SETTING UP OR TAKING DOWN.
